

What's in a name? By Johnny Bremer

Here is a funny little random name generator that you should try and use next time you are in need of a name and can't seem to think of one.

Its very easy to use and does create some interesting names that I bet you never have seen before. This way you also avoid the embarrassment of meeting someone with the exact name you own character has.

First you roll 2d6+3 to determine how many letters the name consist of. Thereafter you roll the appropriate amount of letters on the lettertype table below.

Lettertype Table:

d6	Result
1-4	Roll once on Consonant Main Table
5-6	Roll once on Vowel Table

Consonant Main Table:

2d6	Result
2-4	Roll on Consonant Table One
5-7	Roll on Consonant Table Two
8-9	Roll on Consonant Table Three
10-11	Roll on Consonant Table Four
12	Roll on Consonant Table Five

Consonant Table One:

d6	Result
1-2	L
3-4	N
5	R
6	S

Consonant Table Two:

d6	Result
1-2	D
3-4	H
5	K
6	F

Consonant Table Three:

d6	Result
1-2	T
3-4	M
5	P
6	G

Consonant Table Four:

d6	Result
1-2	B
3-4	C
5	J
6	V

Consonant Table Five:

d6	Result
1-2	Q
3-4	X
5-6	Z

Vowel Table:

2d6	Result
2-4	A
5-6	E
7-8	I
9-10	O
11	U
12	Y

Here are just some of the names I have rolled using this name generator.

1	Daane	6	Jouggiep
2	Oiruhr	7	Ihoemoph
3	Otyetrhivda	8	Aikon
4	Dyakedt	9	Leanhmcaeah
5	Eahjee	10	Pjofeado

Some of the names perhaps isn't as useful as others, but they are surely more interesting and enigmatic than most other names used by the majority of players.

You could even use this generator to create names of places, cities, items, etc.. Happy rolling!
